1.	All applicants are required to apply through online mode on 'CU Chayan Portal' with complete, correct information and attachments. The applicant will be solely responsible for the authenticity of the submitted information. Applicants are required to fill the application form as available on the University website https://www.cusb.ac.in or https://curec.samarth.ac.in . The details regarding qualifications, experience and indicative proformas etc. are available on the University website along with this advertisement. The applicants are required to read these details carefully before filling up the application form.
2.	Applicants should possess the prescribed qualifications and experience as on the closing date of application, as prescribed by the University from time to time for the respective posts.
3.	Applicants are advised to check the University website regularly. The university will not be responsible for invalid/wrong email address and Mobile No., etc. mentioned by the applicants in their online application form.
